Regulations for the Cumulative Doctoral Thesis at the Faculty of Biology

1. Application for the submission of a cumulative doctoral thesis is not necessary.
2. At least two manuscripts have to be accepted in appraised, internationally accepted journals, one publication of them as first-author. You can only apply with an **accepted** paper or a released publication (Decision of the Faculty of 21.12.05/03 and 22.01.2003).
3. If you are a co-author you, have to state your own contribution. The supervisor of your doctoral studies has to confirm your account and you are required to add it to your submitted documents of your submission. The inclusion of a copy of the contribution into your dissertation is possible (Decision of the Faculty of 21.12.05/03 and 22.01.2003).
4. The doctoral thesis must be coherent, which is comprised of an **abstract** in both German **and** English and a **comprehensive, detailed introduction**.
5. The publications have to be included in the original form of the journal as a separate chapter, manuscripts in the form of the doctoral thesis.
6. Following subsequent supplement to the introduction and the publications you have to write a **comprehensive detailed discussion**. An outlook or a general conclusion is not sufficient.
7. Publications as a first author (Original work in a Peer Review Journal) must reflect a **significant part of your doctoral studies**.
8. According to the rules for a Cumulative Promotion, **Review-Articles are not permitted**.
9. Unpublished, but accepted Manuscripts can also be integrated in the thesis.
10. If you have a paper with a **Shared First Authorship**, both authors must sign the **contribution about the respective performance and the substantial part of the publication**.
11. If you want to use Figures from the publications, even your own figures or figures from manuscripts, you must seek permission from the publishing house.
12. The integrated publications can be omitted for the digital version. In their place, please include the link that leads to the publication.
13. A cumulative promotion is not mandatory.
